Plants, cuttings, houseplants, seedlings, vegetables, succulents, alpines, herbs, seed potatoes, small shrubs- anything goes.

The season has now started and it is time to start thinking about **getting ready for our plant sale.**

Past sales have raised over £600, and is one of our main sources of income. It pays for servicing our machinery and hiring skips.

Don't forget the sale whilst splitting up garden perennials, potting cuttings or sowing seed. We can always find homes for surplus plants. Please bring your offerings well before the start time on Sunday morning or, even better, deliver them to the Institute between 4.0 pm and 6.0 pm on the previous Saturday afternoon so that we can price them.

If you want to contribute but cannot make it on the weekend you can leave your plants either by the side gate of 10 Frenchay Road or at the shed on plot 88 during the previous week. Do water them well first.

Please try to pot up plants and label them clearly. It's not easy to sell something anonymous that looks half dead. There is a pot bank for containers by the railway gate entrance. If you have things that are very unusual, you might like to suggest an appropriate price. We aim at about half the going rate of an up-market garden centre. If you can spare a couple of hours setting up and helping at the stalls, particularly early on Sunday morning, we would be very, very grateful. We have become a well-known local fixture and there is often a rush of plant sale groupies who are knocking at the gate even before the start time.
